Following the Call to Order by Mayor Cantrell, Council Member Rankin made the motion to accept the July 5, 2022, Council Meeting Minutes as submitted in writing by the Clerk. Council Member Bartley seconded the motion, and all were in favor. *(Mayor Cantrell voted on all issues in order to meet quorum requirements)*

TANKERSLE REZONING REQUEST - ZONING ORDINANCE AMENDMENT.....

Council Member Bartley made the motion to approve an Eton Zoning Ordinance Amendment which rezones parcel #64A-018 (undeveloped 0.69 acres) from general commercial (C-1) to high density residential (R-3). Council Member Rankin seconded the motion, and the vote was unanimous in favor.

GARBAGE COLLECTION ORDINANCE AMENDMENT 2022-7.....

Council Member Bartley made the motion to amend Eton Ordinance 2022-7 to include "Section 7, Refuse Collection Plans for Developments of More Than Ten (10) Lots." Upon second from Council Member Rankin and a unanimous vote, the motion passed.
